If you do not have regular access to e-mail, you may instead submit one copy of your abstract on a 3 ½ inch floppy disk. Macintosh submissions are not acceptable. **Submissions must include a list of the technology needed for your paper presentation. If no technology is needed for the presentation, please include a note to that effect with your submission.**
